Requests for changes to existing proxy vote arrangements and cancellations must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
- 5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of disability or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, The Elections Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Howell Croft North, Bolton BL1 1QY by 5pm on 26th March 2020. The disability must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
